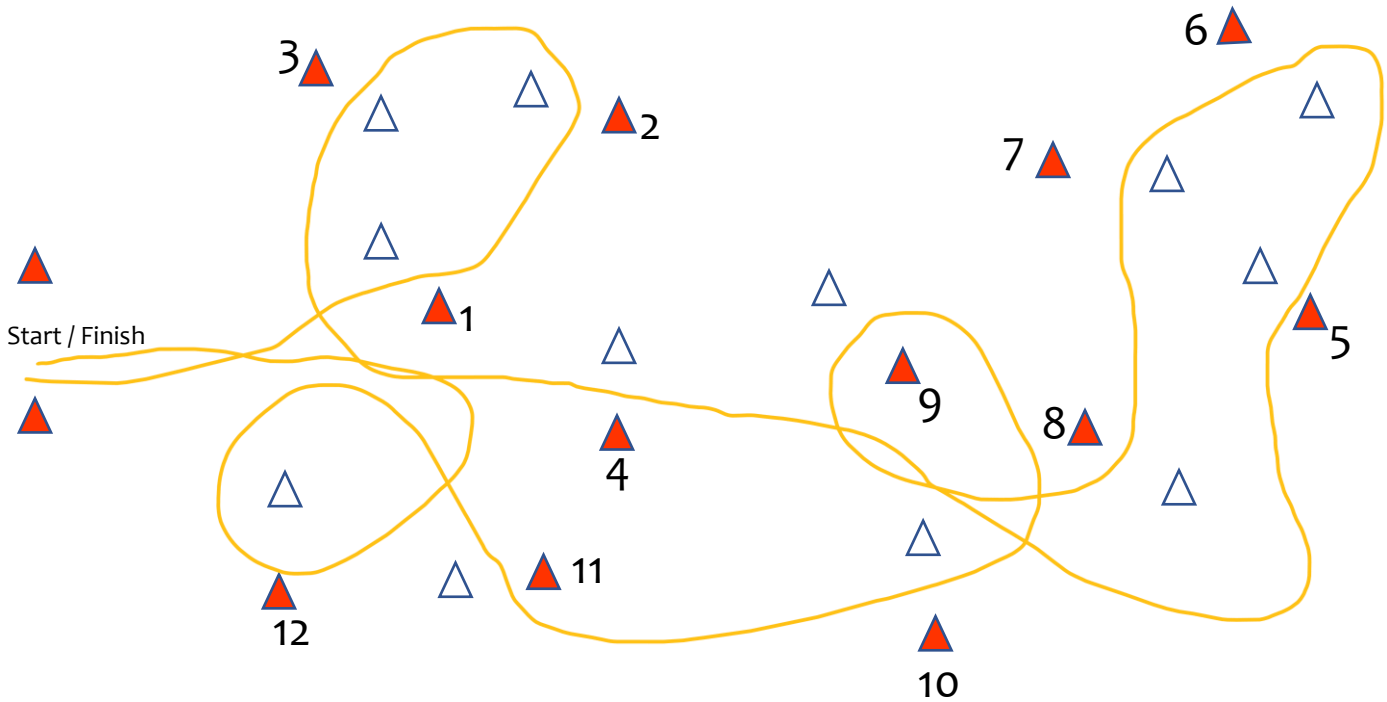

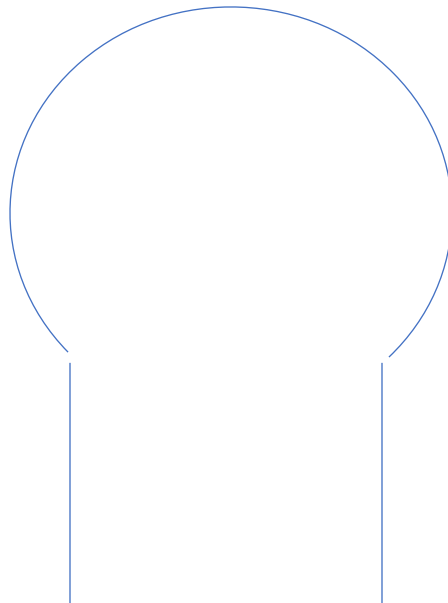
# Ladybug Dash

Drive the marked cones course lined with ladybugs & ladybug flags. Best time wins, it's lively!



# Keyhole Swing

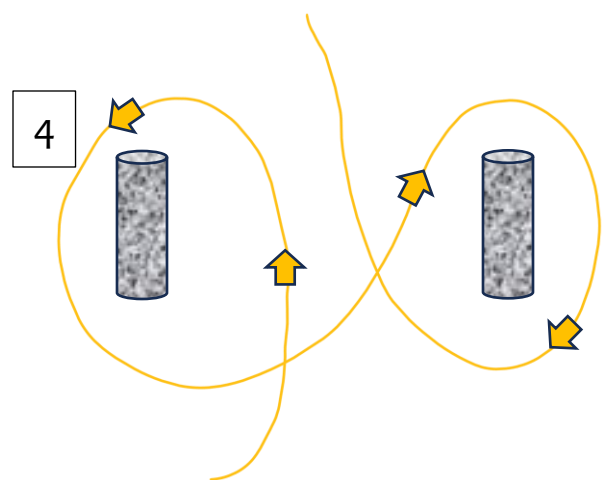
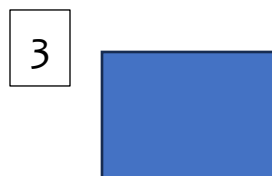
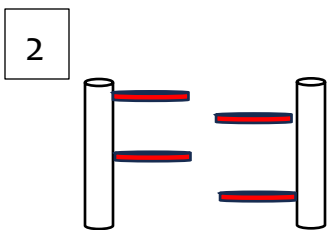
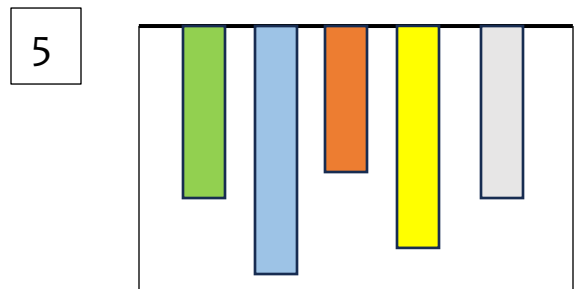
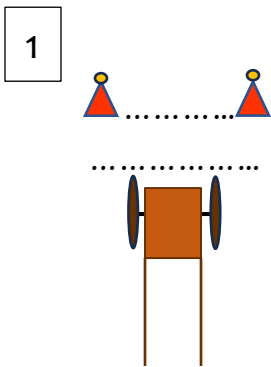
Drive into keyhole, once inside the center of the circle, take three steps to right or left to then swing your cart or carriage to exit the keyhole. The goal is to get your equine to step over to reposition. You can not just drive a circle in the keyhole to exit. Dislodging the poles incurs a 10 second penalty.



# Car(t) Wash

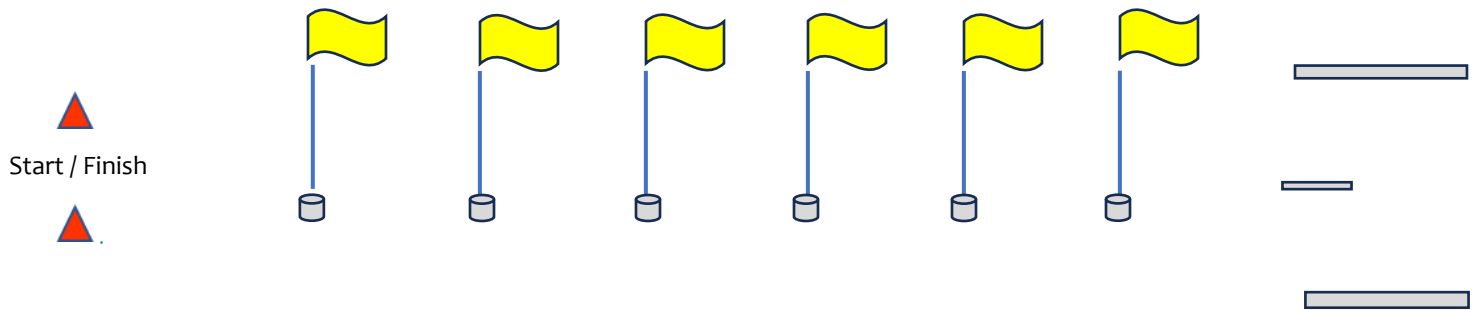
Every vehicle needs a good cleaning. These challenges are worth 10 points each and you have 3 attempts before you need to proceed to the next station. **1.** Start with the entry to the wash, and drive through the cones & 2<sup>nd</sup> line beyond the cones, with your rear wheels over the furthest line, then back up so that your rear wheels are over the line with the cones, without dropping the balls off the cones, then walk forward. **2.** Time for the noodle squeeze, proceed through the noodles. **3.** Wheel wash, walk over the tarp. **4.** Drive a figure 8 around the brushes. **5.** Drive under the scrubbing sheets for you final challenge. Most points and best time, wins.

# Hello Yellow Poles

Poles are placed FAR apart so that you can weave through them with ease. You can start on either side of the Yellow dressed poles, then drive through the ‘U’ and return through the poles to the finish. This is a timed event. A dropped pole or moving the U shaped poles will add 10 seconds to your time.



# Pumpkin Delivery

You are given 3 plastic pumpkins with handles. Place one pumpkin on each of the three barrels, while completing the cloverleaf pattern. 10 points for each pumpkin placed successfully on a barrel. Most points with best time, wins.

**Final note:** Blue Jeans are the expected attire, so no lap robe is necessary. Helmets are strongly encouraged & required if you're under 18 years old. A groom is required if you're driving multiples. Your equines gait is up to you ... walk, trot or canter. If cantering, you must maintain control, with safety as the ultimate goal. The classes will run concurrently, to minimize any wait time and allow you to continue driving from one game course to another. We normally conclude around noon, enjoy lunch together, give out awards, pack up & head home.
